

## Privacy Notice - Electronic Signature (E-Sign)

### Isle of Man Post Office - Controller

Isle of Man Post Office (IOMPO) is a Controller for all personal data processed by the IOMPO, staff or other appointed Officers for the purposes of the General Data Protection Regulation (Isle of Man) Order 2018. The contact details for the IOMPO are Isle of Man Post Office, Postal Headquarters, Spring Valley Industrial Estate, Douglas, Isle of Man IM2 1AA.

In addition to the information set out in the IOMPO privacy notice, we may also collect the following information about you:

- E-mail Address
- Name
- Postal Address
- Electronic Signature
- IP Address

### How we will use the information:

- To obtain an electronic signature on documentation via an ISO certified third party service provider, E-Sign Ltd, 50 Athol Street, Douglas, Isle of Man, IM1 1JB . <https://www.e-sign.co.uk/>
- The documentation will be stored with E-sign and will be fully encrypted, with access limited to Isle of Man Post Office and yourself.

By uploading your electronically signed documents, you are giving IOMPO your consent for them to store your electronically signed documentation you have provided. This process will only happen where this consent has been provided. We will do this in the interest of efficiency and to enable a paperless working environment.

### How we will share the information we collect about you

Third parties we may share your data with include, for example:

- E-Sign for provision of the service
- Police or law enforcement agencies where there is a legal requirement to do so
- Courts on production of a valid court order
- Fraud prevention agencies
- Any other statutory requirements

### How we will store the data we collect from you using a Third party includes:

- E-Sign provides an electronic signature software service which encrypts and stores copies of the electronically signed documentation. The signature is given a digital fingerprint using an algorithm which has 1 in 62 million possibilities. The document is also encrypted for further security and the E-sign website has 256 bit SSL encryption.
- The data will be stored on servers that are within the jurisdiction of the Isle of Man and European Economic Area (EEA)

### E-Sign are compliant with the following:

- ISO27001 certified
- ISO9001 certified
- Cyber essentials certified
- Public Services Network (PSN) accredited

### Protecting your information

Isle of Man Post Office will:

- Keep your information safe and secure in compliance with its information security policy
- Only use and disclose your information as detailed above, where necessary

- Ensure only authorised staff are able to view your data
- Only hold your data on servers that are within the jurisdiction of the Isle of Man and European Economic Area (EEA)
- Retain the information for no longer than is necessary

### Your rights

Right of access to personal information

Other rights

If we do hold information about you, you can ask us to correct any mistakes. You also have the right, subject to any statutory limitations, to object to processing, to erasure or restriction of processing, and to data portability. No automated decisions, or profiling, are undertaken by the Isle of Man Post Office.

Should you require your data to be removed from the E-sign website, a request to do so must be made to the Data Protection Officer, Isle of Man Post Office, as above.

If a document is considered to be of public interest by the Public Records Office a contract may be retained beyond this.</p>

Contracts and other documents where the retention period is less than 14 years will be removed from E-sign upon request from IOMPO.</p>
