

Privacy Notice IMS - Customer Survey

Isle of Man Post Office - Data Controller

Isle of Man Post Office (IOMPO) is a data controller for the purposes of the General Data Protection Regulation (Isle of Man) Order 2018. The contact details for the IOMPO are Isle of Man Post Office, Postal Headquarters, Spring Valley Industrial Estate, Douglas, Isle of Man IM2 IAA.

In addition to the information set out in the IOMPO privacy notice, we may also collect the following information about you:

How we will use the information, we collect about you

IOMPO will use your information to:

- Seek feedback on services provided by the Integrated Mailing Solutions Division (IMS) to fulfil our ISO accreditation obligation to monitor and respond to customer feedback
- The survey can be completed anonymously or contact details can be provided for the purpose of sending a small gift for participating

IOMPO has your consent to check and verify the data you provide to us on the survey form. This will only be done where consent has been provided for us to do so. We will do this to allow us to:

- process the gift
- verify the information and documentation you have provided is correct

How we will share the information we collect about you

Third parties we may share your data with include:

• SurveyMonkey – to allow us to obtain feedback on our service

Protecting your information

Isle of Man Post Office will:

- keep your information safe and secure in compliance with its information security policy
- only use and disclose your information as detailed above, where necessary
- only authorised staff are able to view your data
- retain the information for no longer than is necessary and your information will be permanently deleted once the timeframes set out below have been reached.

Transfer of information outside the EEA

SurveyMonkey may require data to be stored on servers outside of the EEA. Information sent to these will be limited and are as detailed above.

Where your personal data is transferred outside the EEA, we will ensure that it is protected in a manner that is consistent with how your personal data will be protected by us in the EEA. This can be done in a number of ways, for instance:

- the country that we send the data to might be approved by the European Commission or a relevant data protection authority;
- the recipient might have signed up to a contract based on "model contractual clauses" approved by the European Commission, obliging them to protect your personal data; or
- where the recipient is located in the US, it might be a certified member of the EU-US Privacy Shield scheme.

In other circumstances the law may permit us to otherwise transfer your personal data outside the EEA. In all cases, however, we will ensure that any transfer of your personal data is compliant with data protection law
