

Privacy Notice Procurement Exercises

Isle of Man Post Office - Data Controller

Isle of Man Post Office (IOMPO) is a data controller for the purposes of the General Data Protection Regulation (Isle of Man) Order 2018. The contact details for the IOMPO are Isle of Man Post Office, Postal Headquarters, Spring Valley Industrial Estate, Douglas, Isle of Man IM2 1AA.

In addition to the information set out in the IOMPO privacy notice, we may also collect the following information about you:

Categories of personal data / Examples of the type of information (which may vary)
Contact information – Title, name, email address, telephone number, address
Financial data - Quotations and bids submitted in a procurement process
Other information - Feedback, comments, complaints

How we will use the information, we collect about you

IOMPO will use your information to:

- undertake market research, prior to commencing procurement/quotation exercises
- procure goods and services for IOMPO
- help prevent and detect crime
- archiving, transfer and preservation of public records

IOMPO has a legal obligation to check and verify the data you provide to us during a quotation or procurement exercise. This may include checks, where it is necessary and relevant to your application, the information you provide may be disclosed or shared with other organisations.

This will only be done where there is a legal obligation for us to do so. We will do this to allow us to:

- carry out statutory government functions which include running and managing the procurement process
- meet a request you have made for information or a service including procurement process
- verify the information and documentation you have provided is correct, such as obtaining references
- help prevent and detect crime including fraud, money laundering, identity theft or other criminal offences

How we will share the information we collect about you

We may use and disclosure your data for the following reasons:

- staff of IOMPO, advisors, consultants and other professional experts who are involved in the procurement process
- IOMPO Finance Director who deals with appeals lodged against the procurement process

Third parties we may share your data with include:

- Other suppliers to IOMPO
- Attorney General's Chambers (Second Floor, Belgravia House, Circular Road, Douglas IM1 1AE) as an office of the Isle of Man Public Service, which provides legal services on procurement matters to IOMPO
- Income Tax Division of Treasury (a Department of the Isle of Man Government) who confirms to IOMPO that no outstanding statutory payments are due
- police or law enforcement agencies where there is a legal requirement to do so
- courts on production of a valid court order
- fraud prevention agencies

Protecting your information

Isle of Man Post Office will:

- keep your information safe and secure in compliance with its information security policy
- only use and disclose your information as detailed above, where necessary
- only permit authorised staff to view your data
- only hold your data on servers that are under the control of the Isle of Man Post Office and within the jurisdiction of the Isle of Man
- retain the information for no longer than is necessary and your information will be permanently deleted once the timeframes set out below have been reached.

Your rights

You have a right to access your personal data to ensure that it is accurate, and to request that it is rectified, blocked, erased or destroyed if it is inaccurate.
