To send money



1. Fill out the Send Form to tell us where you need the money to go. Give your completed form and the money to the MoneyGram agent. They will give you a Reference Number and a receipt.



2. Let the person you're sending money to know the amount to expect and the Reference Number they'll need to pick up the money.



3. Let them know what identification to take to the MoneyGram agent. This could be a passport, a driving licence, or any official document issued by the Government.

To receive money



1. The sender will let you know how much money to expect. They will also give you a Reference Number.



2. Before you go to the MoneyGram agent, remember to pick up your ID. This could be a passport, a driving licence, or any official document issued by the Government. You may also need to provide Proof of Address (a bank statement or utility bill). The rules vary by country, so please ask your local MoneyGram agent to tell you what you need to bring.



3. Fill in a Receive form in store and give it, with your ID, to the MoneyGram agent.



4. The MoneyGram agent will enter your information into the system and check that the money is available for you, before paying out.
